NON-SUTURED WOUND POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cleanse the wound area with soap and water twice a day.
2. Apply Polysporin or Bacitracin antibiotic ointment or Vaseline to the wound after it is cleaned. (available at your local pharmacy without a prescription)
3. You may cover it with a Band-Aid if you like; if not, it may be left open to the air. It is probably best to cover it at least half the day.
4. You may get the wound wet and it can be cleaned with soap and water when you are in the shower.
5. Please call us if the wound appears red or has a greenish discharge or does not seem to be healing properly.

A biopsy may have been sent to the laboratory from your surgery today. If it shows cancer or a condition that requires further treatment, you will be notified.
